### **Ordinance No. 2702-26**

#### **Amending Various Sections of Chapter 2 and Article IV to ensure standardizing language related to boards and commissions**

This ordinance amends various sections of Chapter 2 and Article IV of the St. Louis Park City Code related to boards and commissions. Most of the amendments include changes that are grammatical or structural and intended to improve readability or provide clarity. More notable changes to the code include the removal of purpose sections for the Human Rights Commission and the Environment and Sustainability commission, the removal of “qualified voter” as a requirement for service on boards and commissions, and lastly changes that streamlines the Board of Zoning Appeals membership section by removing language that duplicated Planning commission requirements, as the members of this board function as an extension of the Planning Commission.

The ordinance shall take effect March 27, 2026.
